- Copy of your NREMT certificate (Not a picture from a phone)
- Copy of your current CPR card (Not a picture from a phone)
- A completed and signed IDPH Renewal Notice form printable from <https://dph.illinois.gov/topics-services/emergency-preparedness-response/ems/licensing>.
