PURPOSE:

To identify training standards and continuing education requirements for the Emergency Medical Responder per Title 77: Public Health Chapter I: Department of Public Health Subchapter f: Emergency Medical Services and Highway Safety Part 515.725 Emergency Medical Responder.

POLICY:

- 1. To register as a First Responder, the individual must submit the following to the EMS office:
 - a. A completed First Responder registration form prescribed by IDPH, which shall include, but not limited to, the First Responder's name, address, and the employer and supervisor when the individual is acting as a First Responder. (Section 3-60(b)(3) of the Act)
 - b. Documentation of successful completion of training in accordance with the current National EMS Educational Standards for First Responders or its equivalent and training in CPR.
 - 2. A First Responder shall notify IDPH in writing within 10 days after any changes in:
 - a. EMS System participation
 - b. The First Responder's employer or Supervisor; and Name or address

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
