PURPOSE:

1. It is the responsibility of the qualifying candidate to make certain that his/her Field Internship meets the State and local requirements. It is the responsibility of the SFVEMSS Course Coordinator to oversee the field time.

POLICY:

- 1. EMT-Paramedic students may begin EMT299 Field Internship after the successful completion of EMT230 Hospital Clinical II and EMT231 Field Clinical II.
- 2. The Field Internship is to be completed as outlined the Field Internship Guidelines and Grading Criteria issued to each student at the beginning of EMT299.
- 3. The student's field experiences will be overseen by three (3) to five (5) Paramedics/PHRNs led by the Primary Preceptor. The student will be able to ride with any one of these individuals during their field clinical and field internship as outlined in Policy C-30.0
- 4. Appropriate documentation of all field runs must be completed per the Grading Criteria.
- 5. A passing grade of 'C' or better must be achieved in EMT299 Field Internship for successful completion of the course.
