**PURPOSE:**

1. It is the responsibility of the qualifying candidate to make certain that his/her Field Internship meets the State and local requirements. It is the responsibility of the SFVEMSS Course Coordinator to oversee the field time.

**POLICY:**

1. EMT-Paramedic students may begin EMT299 Field Internship after the successful completion of EMT230 Hospital Clinical II and EMT231 Field Clinical II.
2. The Field Internship is to be completed as outlined the Field Internship Guidelines and Grading Criteria issued to each student at the beginning of EMT299.
3. The student's field experiences will be overseen by three (3) to five (5) Paramedics/PHRNs led by the Primary Preceptor. The student will be able to ride with any one of these individuals during their field clinical and field internship as outlined in Policy C-30.0
4. Appropriate documentation of all field runs must be completed per the Grading Criteria.
5. A passing grade of 'C' or better must be achieved in EMT299 Field Internship for successful completion of the course.
