PURPOSE:

To explain the criteria for an EMT-P candidate, who had attended prior EMT-P training, and an inactive EMT-P wishing to re-license or reactivate their license.

POLICY:

1. EMT-Paramedic students that fail to achieve a 'C' in all mandatory courses may reenter the Paramedic Training Program in accordance with the SFVEMSS Paramedic Training Program Handbook.

2. Candidates are only allowed one additional attempt at the Paramedic Training Program.

For inactive EMT-Paramedics that wish to re-license or reactive their license eligibility will be based on a case by case incident with the approval of the Southern Fox Valley EMS Medical Director, with a recommendation from the EMS Administrative Director, EMS System Coordinator

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
