PURPOSE:

To explain the criteria for an EMT-P candidate, who had attended prior EMT-P training, and an inactive EMT-P wishing to re-license or reactivate their license.

POLICY:

- 1. EMT-Paramedic students that fail to achieve a 'C' in all mandatory courses may reenter the Paramedic Training Program in accordance with the SFVEMSS Paramedic Training Program Handbook.
- 2. Candidates are only allowed one additional attempt at the Paramedic Training Program.

For inactive EMT-Paramedics that wish to re-license or reactive their license eligibility will be based on a case by case incident with the approval of the Southern Fox Valley EMS Medical Director, with a recommendation from the EMS Administrative Director, EMS System Coordinator

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
