PURPOSE:

In compliance with Section 515.330 L(10) the following actions will be taken if a system participant is convicted of a felonious crime whether on or off duty.

POLICY:

- 1. When it is discovered that a system participant has been convicted of a felony, the EMS administrative team will consult the participant's employer to determine what action has been taken.
- 2. If it is determined that the participant represents a danger to the public or coworkers, the individual will be suspended in accordance with System policy.
- 3. The convicted individual will be afforded due process, and if it is determined that the participant does not represent a threat to the public or coworkers, he/she may continue to function in his/her role as defined by his/her employer (pending appeal).

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
