PURPOSE:

To define the scope of commitments shared by SFVEMS System Agency participants.

POLICY:

1. All SFVEMS pre-hospital provider agencies shall participate in financial support of the system.
 - a. Financial assessments will be made, and payment will be received by the System Resource Hospital on an annual basis.
 - b. Failure to comply with system financial obligations will result in disciplinary action as prescribed by the Illinois Administrative Code Section 515.420

2. All Vehicle Service Providers shall have a designated Pediatric Emergency Care Coordinator (PECC) who assists in ensuring that the agency and personnel are prepared to care for ill and injured children. Oversight, training, and education can be validated by conducting activities such as confirming the availability of pediatric equipment and supplies, ensuring that personnel follow pediatric protocols and participate in pediatric education, and promoting family-centered care.
 - a. The EMS System Coordinator will hold this position for each vehicle service provider in the EMS System.

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
